The Ohio River Trail Council (ORTC) is a non-profit, volunteer-led corporation whose mission is to establish, promote, protect and preserve a multi-use trail, the Ohio River Trail (ORT), along the Ohio River and its tributaries from the Columbiana Greenway Trail, near East Liverpool, OH and Chester, WV to the Great Allegheny Passage (GAP) via the Montour Trail in Moon Township, Pa, and the Three Rivers Heritage Trail in Pittsburgh, Pa.
