

## **Ohio River Trail Council sets open house for March 28**

CENTER TWP. -- The Ohio River Trail Council welcomes visitors to explore its Water Trail Map and Guide and its future projects at an open house from 3 to 6 p.m. March 28 at Community College of Beaver County in Center Township.

The 69-mile water trail map and guide describes the geographical area that extends from Ohio River in Pittsburgh to Newell, W.Va., and East Liverpool, Ohio, and includes sections of the Beaver River and Raccoon and Little Beaver creeks.

Results of a feasibility study for a 41-mile bike and pedestrian trail along the Ohio River from Coraopolis to Ohioville and information about the Environmental Protection Agency-approved Brownfield Reuse Planning project for Monaca, Aliquippa, Coraopolis and Midland will be available.
