GENERAL: The Ohio River Trail Council (ORTC) is committed to make this year's Gear and Cheer Music Festival series a great success. We can typically expect a lovely day with mild winds and warm temperatures.

DATE & LOCATION: **Spring:** TBD. **Summer:** July 15, 2017. The Summer festival is located at Four Seasons Pavilion at Bradys Run Park - Beaver County, PA. GPS 40.724079, -80.362849. **Fall:** October 15, 2016. The Fall festival is located at the Moon Township Community Park and the Montour Woods Conservation Area - Moon Township, PA. GPS: 40.490416, -80.183690

PARTICIPATION: Alcohol Vendors are located inside the Pavilion. Selection is based on a first-come first-served basis using the date of registration; therefore, please submit your application at your earliest opportunity. All locations within the pavilion are excellent and are handicapped accessible, therefore specific spaces are not guaranteed. The location of Vendor's Space will be at the sole discretion of the Festival committee.



HOURS OF OPERATION: **Vendor arrival is between 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. eastern standard time.** Beer & Wine Tasting occurs from 11:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. Vendor parking is reserved near the Pavilion.

VENDOR FEES/FREE TICKETS: There is no required donation fee to the ORTC for alcohol vendors who provide tasting samples. The Vendor receives four (4) complimentary tasting tickets (\$100 value) for festival staff. Wine Vendors (Limited Winery Licensee) who also want to sell product may need to obtain a wine exposition permit. Alcohol vendors can sell any product as long as it meets Pennsylvania laws and regulations.

VENDOR OBLIGATIONS & EQUIPMENT: The ORTC provides tasting glasses, tables, chairs, ice and electricity. Vendors will be required to provide all equipment to be used for display, sales and the preparation and serving of drink items, including refrigeration if necessary. All Vendors shall be responsible for cleaning their space during and after the event. All garbage must be disposed in the trashcans provided or in the dumpster behind the lodge. Please contact the ORTC if you need assistance with any of the above.

LIABILITY & LICENSES: Vendor assumes all responsibility for a) loss, personal injury and/or liability for any damage to its property or merchandise; and b) any sickness or illness caused from the food and/or drink served from its concession. The ORTC is to be held harmless for any liability or loss caused by theft, damage, destruction, injuries or negligence. Vendor expressly agrees to indemnify, protect and hold harmless the Promoter; its officers, directors, principals, executive committee members, festival sponsors from any liability whatsoever in connection with this event. The Vendor agrees to name the ORTC as an additional insured on the Vendors general liability insurance coverage through a Certificate of Insurance. All licenses and permits to sell foods including the FDA and Department of Agriculture is the sole responsibility of the Vendor.

DISCLAIMER: The festival will be held rain or shine since the Pavilion is an indoor facility. The ORTC makes no representation as to the number of potential Festival attendees and assumes no liability for any financial loss.
