You are cordially invited to perform at the Ohio River Trail Council Gear & Cheer Music Festival on July 19, 2015. Free events includes live music along with kayaking, canoeing, stand-up paddleboarding, kids' fishing derby, and arts & crafts. Pay events includes a kayak race, 5K run/walk, mountain biking, road cycling, rock climbing wall, cornhole tournament, auctions, raffles, food, drink, wine and beer tasting.

The ORTC Festival is also comprised of non-profit, educational, environmental, heritage, government, and trail groups primarily from Ohio, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia. The Gear & Cheer Music Festival at the Lodge in Bradys Run Park, which is Beaver County's largest park and consists of nearly 2000 acres. Bradys Run Park is located on Route 51, two miles north of Beaver, Pa within Brighton and Patterson Townships.

Just imagine a multi-use trail along the Ohio River! The Ohio River Trail Council (ORTC) is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit, volunteer-led, public benefit corporation comprised of business and civic leaders, interested property owners, and community residents. The Ohio River Trail Council's goal is to promote and protect a continuous corridor of natural and cultural resources along the Ohio River and its tributaries, as well as honor our past and build our future by providing recreation opportunities, environmental stewardship, land conservation, heritage development, safe transportation networks, and economic stimulus to our region.

The Ohio River Trail Council Music Festival is a fundraising event where all of the proceeds are used for the development of a forty-mile multi-use land and water trail system along the Ohio River and its tributaries, known as the Ohio River Trail in southwestern Pennsylvania. As a tool for ecology and the environment, the Ohio River Trail will preserve the natural landscape, safeguard wildlife diversity, and provide vital habitat corridors thereby providing opportunities for bicycling, hiking, paddling, birding, butterflying, deer spotting, fishing or enjoying the spring wildflowers or the peak autumn colors.

Our Bands are volunteers who are dedicated individuals that have a sincere concern for the welfare of others and the environment. They are serving others by supporting our cause without expecting anything in return. Nonetheless, the Ohio River Trail Council (ORTC) will provide you with a complimentary event tickets except for the cornhole tournament and a 10' x 10' area to setup a tent/booth to sell merchandise during the festival. Each band is to bring advertising signage and banners as well as furnish tables, chairs, tents, extension cords and power surge protectors for the event. However, the ORTC may be able to provide assistance with any of the above by request. In addition, the ORTC is providing a complimentary ticket to any of the pay events, including beer and wine tasting, for each band member, manager and guest. Each volunteer also receives a festival t-shirt and tasting glass.

The ORTC is an organization committed to excellence, with a clear vision and a passion for delivering outstanding results. Our members and volunteers who donate their time and talents say they feel rewarded many times over for the help they provide in making a difference in the lives of others. Their personal participation in our projects creates a sense of ownership and promotes civic pride.
