OHIO RIVER GREENWAY TRAIL

The Ohio River Greenway Trail (ORGT) is a multi-use corridor, which is a key segment of an extensive trail system being developed in the "Keystone State." The green trail is also serving to complete an essential section in a nationally, significant linear park system, called the "Industrial Heartland Trail," through the interconnection of existing trails in five states – Maryland, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia, as well as a link to the "Great American Rail Trail."

OHIO RIVER WATER TRAIL

The Ohio River Water Trail (ORWT) is a tri-state blueways system that navigates the counties of Allegheny, Beaver, Columbiana, and Hancock in the states of Ohio, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia. The ORWT is a 69-mile blue trail that supports an enhanced river recreation experience on 46-miles of the Ohio River, 3-miles of the Beaver River, 4-miles of Raccoon Creek, and 16-miles of Little Beaver Creek. The ORWT is a National Recreation Trail (NRT) which is an honor given to exemplary trails that connects people to their local resources while improving their quality of life.

BICYCLEPA ROUTE A

BicyclePA is a series of bicycle routes created by PennDOT to cross the state on highways and rail trails. The 199-mile BicyclePA Route A runs from the West Virginia border south of Mount Morris in Greene County north to Coraopolis, Monaca, Beaver Falls, and ends in Presque Isle State Park on Lake Erie in Erie, Pennsylvania.

UNDERGROUND RAILROAD WALKING TOUR

New Brighton played a major part in the Underground Railroad thanks in part to the Ohio River. Since the river bordered many slave states, the waterway served as a natural pathway for runaway slaves to reach safe houses in the North. The Underground Railroad Walking Trail includes nine of the New Brighton sites associated with the abolitionist movement. A guided tour is available in September.

UNDERGROUND RAILROAD BICYCLE ROUTE

The Adventure Cycling Association Underground Railroad Bicycle Route (UGRR) memorializes a network of clandestine routes by which African freedom seekers attempted to escape slavery before and during the Civil War. The 153-mile UGRR Pittsburgh Spur runs between Pittsburgh, Coraopolis, Monaca, Beaver Falls, and Erie, Pennsylvania.

NEW BRIGHTON IS A BOROUGH IN BEAVER COUNTY ALONG THE BEAVER RIVER, 25-MILES NORTHWEST OF PITTSBURGH.

New Brighton is the perfect balance of a walkable downtown and suburban living for any individual or family. Since its incorporation in 1838, New Brighton has been a home for all generations and demonstrated the ability to balance its celebrated history with the demand for new development.

New Brighton offers a variety of recreation and cultural activities and an attractive business district that provides an assortment of stores and services for residents as well as visitors.

Third Avenue (State Route 65/18) is the main artery of downtown New Brighton. The five-block area of Third Avenue, from Eighth Street to Thirteenth Street, was recently renovated during a \$2.5 million streetscape project that resulted in a well illuminated, accessible, and pedestrian friendly area that provides a welcoming and safe place to dine and shop.

The downtown offers pedestrians, drivers, and cyclists access to numerous shops, boutiques, and eateries as well as several walkable connections to the Beaver River, where residents and visitors can fish at the New Brighton Fishing Park and picnic, walk, or nature watch at Big Rock Park which currently boasts an active bald eagle nest.
