

Montour Woods Conservation Area

This conservation area in Moon Township protects 260 acres of wildlife habitat and eight miles of wooded trails open to the public for hiking, biking and enjoyment of nature. *Note: Motorized vehicles are prohibited.*

TRAILS

Eight miles of wooded trails provide hiking, mountain biking and birding opportunities. Trails include uneven surfaces and stream crossings.

Meeks Run Trail: ~1.5 miles, wide, flat, stream crossings, vernal pools

Oil Well Trail: ~1 mile, narrow, some hills

Cave Trail: ~0.25 miles, wide, flat, stream crossing

Hemlocks Trail: ~1.5 miles, narrow, quite hilly

Highlands Trail: ~0.75 miles, narrow, some hills

Honeydew Trail: ~1 mile, narrow, some hills

Powerline Trail: ~0.5 miles, wide, steep

Baseball Trail: ~0.75 miles, mostly flat, some hills

Nike Trail: ~0.5 miles, mostly flat, some hills

MEEKS RUN

This lovely little stream is the cleanest tributary of Montour Run, supporting nearly 20 species of fish.

NIKE MISSILE SITE

Named for the Greek goddess of victory, the former US military site provided air defense during the Cold War. A partial fence marks the boundary of the conservation area and the former missile site.
